Tenure Track Professor of Perioperative Outcomes Research at the Division of General Anaesthesiology, Emergency and Intensive Care Medicine Part-time position (50%)

We are looking for an excellent scientist/researcher with great potential to develop an internationally renowned research agenda in the field of perioperative outcomes research.

The successful candidate should be a qualified expert in perioperative outcomes and promote it in research and teaching.

The initial appointment is limited to six years. After the conclusion of a qualification agreement (assistant professor), the career advancement goal is to transfer to a tenured position as an associate professor (tenure track professor pursuant to § 99 para. 5 and 6 of the Universities Act). If the candidate demonstrates outstanding and remarkable achievements, the qualification agreement may be fulfilled as quickly as possible.

Core duties and responsibilities:

- Conducting cutting-edge scientific research in the field of perioperative outcomes research
- Acquiring competitive third-party funding and taking the lead in research projects
- Establishing an internationally renowned multidisciplinary team
- Teaching at the university and advising students pursuing human medicine diplomas and doctoral studies
- Mentoring and promoting young researchers
- Establishing and maintaining networks and collaborations with national and international partner institutions
- Supporting scientific and public outreach in his/her research area (public lectures, media, etc.)

Successful candidates must have the following qualifications:

- Degree in human medicine and a related doctoral degree
- Specialist (Facharzt) in anaesthesiology
- Excellent track record with publications in leading journals and third-party acquisition of funding for perioperative outcomes research
- Experience in teaching and/or (co)supervising doctoral students and/or training of post-doctoral fellows (depending on the applicant's career stage)

- National and international scientific collaborations
- High level of proficiency in both written and spoken German and English (proficiency level C1)

The ideal candidate has the following profile:

- Highly willing to engage in interdisciplinary and interprofessional cooperation
- Highly motivated to achieve academic excellence in research and teaching as well as capable of inspiring colleagues and students
- Responsible work habits, resilience and ability to solve problems
