The post may be extended on agreement to a maximum of 2 years, with opportunities to transfer to other sites. These services are supported by the Intensive Care Units at each site - Charing Cross Hospital is a tertiary referral centre for oncology, head and neck surgery and neurosurgery; Hammersmith Hospital provides cardiothoracic, renal and haem-oncology services in addition to being the site of the world renowned Queen Charlotte's and Chelsea Hospital; whilst St Mary's Hospital is the UK's top performing trauma centre (TARN data) as well as providing general services to the local population.

We are busy, friendly departments fully accredited for training in Intensive Care Medicine and have an expanding research profile led by a Professor of Critical Care Medicine and team. Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust has a close working relationship with Imperial College London, one of the world's leading academic institutions. The hospitals are situated in West London with excellent transport links and easy access to Central London.

The successful applicant will join a team of junior doctors and consultants who provide cover to the ICU. You will join the middle grade rota and engage in critical care services outside the ICU, such as seeing referrals, as well as caring for patients in ICU and supervising more junior members of the team. All juniors are welcome to get involved in teaching, research and quality improvement activity within the department. All rotas are European Working Time Directive compliant. Applicants are encouraged to study for postgraduate examinations in Intensive Care Medicine. There are opportunities available to gain experience in simulation training, medical student teaching as well as research and management.

Applicants must have GMC registration. In addition a further post graduate qualification or part thereof is highly desirable. Airway skills are essential. This post would suit an applicant at registrar level or an applicant who wishes to gain further experience in a teaching hospital ICU. Overseas applicants welcome and this post will be available for Tier 2 visa holders.
